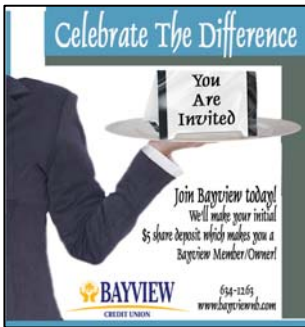


Bayview's seven branches are ready to offer any and all help these members need to make the transition and to help them reach all their financial goals.

Bayview Proudly Presents Men of the Deeps In Support of the RCR Education Fund for the Children of Fallen Soldiers

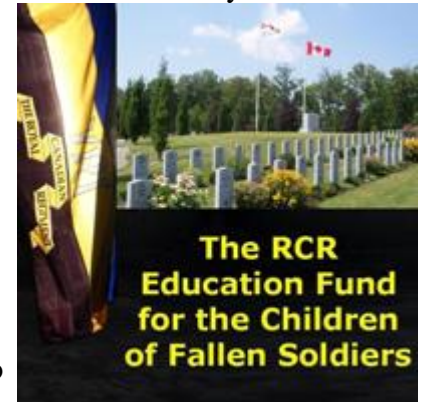
