

How to: PIN your debit card.

If you have received a new debit card directly from your credit union, you will need to activate the Personal Identification Number (PIN) at the ATM. Below is a step by step guide to assist you with the process.

1. Insert your debit card.
2. ***Please select desired language.***
Select your language.
3. ***Please enter your PIN. Press Enter/OK when complete.***
Enter the temporary PIN number provided by your credit union. Press OK.
4. ***Would you like a receipt for your transaction?***
Press Yes and you will receive confirmation you PIN has been changed.
5. ***Select a transaction.***
Choose PIN change.
6. ***Please enter your new Personal Identification Number. Press Enter/OK when complete.***
Enter the new a four-digit PIN number you would like to use. Press OK.
7. ***Please confirm your Personal Identification Number. Press Enter/OK when complete.***
Re-enter your new four-digit PIN number (same as #6 above). Press OK.
8. ***Your PIN has been changed. Please remove your card.***
You PIN has now been changed.
9. Take your receipt (which should indicate a successful PIN change). You may wish to test your new PIN by completing an inquiry transaction.
